


## Jesus Changes Paul





Paul and Silas knew Jesus was with them—but the jailer was very frightened. "What must I do to be saved?" he cried. "Believe in Jesus!" said Paul.


The jailer did believe—and so did his whole family. Paul baptized everyone at the jailer's house. It was a happy night!

### **Dear Family:**


Ask your child to tell you the exciting story of Paul and Silas in prison at Philippi (Acts 16) by arranging their story pictures and gluing them in the correct frames on the inside pages. Spend some time this week singing about your own love for Jesus too. (Check out the simple project below, and make an instrument to accompany your praise.)

### **Directions:**

- 1. Cover one end of a toilet paper tube with paper.
- 2. Place a rubber band tightly around it.
- 3. Pour a handful or beans or rice into the open end.
- 4. Cover the open end with paper and secure it with another rubber band.
- 5. Decorate your shaker.
- 6. Attach crepe paper streamers to one end.
