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Jesus Dies

The Palm Sunday parade of praise for Jesus had been so happy. But now things were so very sad. There were people who hated Jesus and didn't believe he was really God's Son. They wanted to get rid of Jesus. So one night when Jesus went to his favor te place to pray, they followed him with some soldiers. The soldiers arrested him and brought him to Pilate, their ruler.

The soldiers made fun of Jasus. They dressed him up like a pretend king and put a crown of thorns on his head. A crowd of people watched and shouted, "Kill him! Kill Jesus!" And that is exactly what Pilate decided to do.

The soldiers made Jesus carry a cross on his back until he was too tired and sore to go another step. Happy enemies and sad friends followed Jesus and the soldiers to a hill called Calvary. There the soldiers hung Jesus on the cross and stood it up for everyone to see. Then they waited for Jesus to die.

Jesus was in pain, but he didn't complain because he knew he was dying for his friends—friends like you and me. Jesus was dying because he loves us.

Jesus' friends didn't know that yet, and they cried. After a while, Jesus said, "It is finished." And he died.

Two of Jesus' friends took his body down from the cross. They wrapped Jesus' body in linen cloths and put sweet-smelling spices around it. Then they laid Jesus' body in a special tomb and rolled a giant rock in front of the opening. It was a very sad day.

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Today your child heard the sad story of Jesus' death (John 18-19). Your child also gave thanks for Jesus' love—a love so great that he died for us. It was a session of contrasts! Read the story on page 1, then see God's Big Story card no. 133 for further activities and discussion starters.

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
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
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Dear Family:


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






Dear Family:
