


So Jesus' friends waited for the Holy Spirit. They knew Jesus was with them—and they knew Jesus was in heaven as Lord over heaven and all the earth!



Jesus' disciples were in Jerusalem too. They were waiting. Jesus had told them to wait for a special gift they would receive—the Holy Spirit.




